

Introduction to the Prophetic Bible Event (with Supportive Scriptures)  
of the *Day of the Lord of Hosts—Jehovah Tsaba* (Isaiah 2:12 and Psalms 24)

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for “doctrine, reproof, correction, and instruction in righteousness” (2 Timothy 3:16)

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God has chosen to bring to light to the BOC an end time message to the Church of the wealth transfer, the plunder, the gathering of the economic harvest. It is a vengeance (inflicted in retaliation for an injury or offense) to comfort (Isaiah 61:2-3), not a judgment.

A flood is coming—a deluge of wealth, untold amounts. We have not ever seen anything like this before! God’s promises are just too good to be true, anyhow. It is time to agree with God, say “yes” and take the anointing for the *Day of the Lord of Hosts—Jehovah Tsaba*.

As to understanding any Bible truth, the Word of God is our stand and focus. There are many Biblical promises attached to this **Day** and unique to this event, some included in this handout, but not all.

**Initial Questions to Ponder and Ask**

1. What in the world is going on?
2. Why is it happening?
3. Why is it happening now?
4. Who is going to gain from what is happening?
5. Would my God really do this?
6. Isn’t wealth the cause of all sin and problems?
7. What is the Body of Christ’s response to be?
8. What is my response?

**Key Players**

The Lord of Host (Psalms 24) God’s family (Haggai 2) The wicked in the earth (James 5)

**Why shake the economics and take from the wicked?**

“Thou shalt arise, and have mercy upon Zion: for the time to favor (Hebrew means to bend or stoop over to an inferior to bestow a gift) her; yea, the set time, is come.” Psalms 102:13

“So the nations shall fear and worshipfully revere the name of the Lord, and all the kings of the earth Your glory. (16) When the Lord builds up Zion, He will appear in His glory; (17) He will regard the plea of the destitute and will not despise their prayer. (18) Let this be recorded for the generation yet unborn, that a people yet to be created shall praise the Lord. (19) For He looked down from the height of His sanctuary, from heaven did the Lord behold the earth, (20) To hear the sighing and groaning of the prisoner, to lose those who are appointed to death.” Psalms 102:15-20

“Jehovah of Hosts has sworn, saying, Surely as I have thought, so it shall be; and as I have purposed, it shall rise up; (25)... Then his yoke shall depart from them, and his burden shall depart from his shoulders. (26) This is the purpose that is purposed on all the earth; and this the hand that is stretched out on all the nations. (27) For Jehovah of Hosts has purposed. And who shall reverse it? And His hand is stretched out. Who shall turn it back?” Isaiah 14:24-27

“Jehovah of Hosts has purposed it, to stain the pride of all glory, to bring all the honored of the earth into contempt.” Isaiah 23:9

**Why give wealth to the righteous?**

“O Jehovah, how many are Your works! You have made all of them in wisdom; the earth is full of Your riches.” Psalms 104:24

“The wealth of the sinner is laid up for the just in whom it belongs and will eventually come.” Prov. 13:22

### **God's plan--the precious fruit of the earth--souls!**

“Hear this, you rich of this world's society: it is soon to be your turn to weep and howl over the woes which you will surely find coming upon you. (2) Your wealth and abundance has been corrupted and is now waiting to be discarded like garbage, and your physical store of possessions are moth-eaten. (3) Your gold and silver are restrained of any real elements of glory, and now their contaminated state will speak out against you. Instead of helping in this time of trouble, it will devour your flesh as if it were fire. You have collectively heaped together treasure for the end of the ages. (4) Listen carefully, and you will hear crying out against you the very wages that you have withheld by fraud from laborers who have harvested your field. Yes, they are crying out of the discomfort you have brought them, they are seeking God to bring vengeance, and the cries of the harvesters have come to the attention of Jehovah Sabaoth [Greek transliteration of the Old Testament Jehovah Tsaba.] (5) God has judged you, guilty of giving yourselves over to soft living and grossly self indulgent pleasures. Your hearts were made fat from the slaughter of those you carelessly threw away in battle in order to secure your riches. (6) Through your conduct, you condemned and murdered the innocent of the earth, as he was powerless to resist you. James 5:1-6

“The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, To preach the acceptable year of the Lord. And he closed the book.” Luke 4:18-29

### **Has this ever happened before?**

“And [God] said to Abram, Know positively that your descendants will be strangers dwelling as temporary residents in a land that is not theirs [Egypt], and they will be slaves there and will be afflicted and oppressed for 400 years [fulfilled in Exodus 12:40]. (14) But I will bring judgment on that nation whom they will serve, and afterward they will come out with great possessions. Genesis 15:13-14

“And I will give this people favour in the sight of the Egyptians: and it shall come to pass, that, when ye go, ye shall not go empty: But every woman shall borrow of her neighbour, and of her that sojourneth in her house, jewels of silver, and jewels of gold, and raiment: and ye shall put them upon your sons, and upon your daughters; and ye shall spoil the Egyptians.” Exodus 3:21-22

### **Why is it called the Day of the Lord of Hosts?**

“The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, and the haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, and the Lord alone shall be exalted in that day. (12) For the day of Jehovah of hosts [Heb. Jehovah Tsaba] shall be upon every one that is proud and lofty, and upon every one that is lifted up; and he shall be brought low.” (17) “And the loftiness of man shall be bowed down, and the haughtiness of men shall be made low: and the Lord alone shall be exalted in that day.” Isaiah 2:11-12, 17

### **Who is the Lord of Hosts?**

“Lift up your heads, O ye gates; and be ye lift up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in. (8) Who is this King of glory? The Lord strong and mighty, the Lord mighty in battle. (9) Lift up your heads, O ye gates; even lift them up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in. (10) Who is this King of glory? The Lord of hosts, he is the King of glory.” Psalms 24:7-10

“And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory” [or Heb. His glory is the fullness of the whole earth” (from Treasury of Scriptural Knowledge)]. Isaiah 6:3

### **How will God's army come and operate?**

“Then [at Mount Sinai] His voice shook the earth, but now He has given a promise: Yet once more I will shake and make tremble not only the earth but also the [starry] heavens (Hag. 2:6).” Hebrews 12:26

“So the angel who talked with me said to me, Cry out, Thus says the Lord of hosts... (15) I am very angry with the nations that are at ease; for while I was but a little displeased, they helped forward the affliction and disaster [of my people].” Zechariah 1:14-15

“For thus saith the Lord of hosts; After the glory hath he sent me unto the nations which spoiled you: for he that toucheth you toucheth the apple of his eye. (9) For, behold, I will shake mine hand upon them, and they shall be a spoil to their servants: and ye shall know that the Lord of hosts hath sent me. (10) Sing and rejoice, O daughter of Zion: for, lo, I come, and I will dwell in the midst of thee, saith the Lord. (11) And many nations shall be joined to the Lord in that day, and shall be my people: and I will dwell in the midst of thee, and thou shalt know that the Lord of hosts hath sent me unto thee. (13) Be silent, O all flesh, before the Lord: for he is raised up out of his holy habitation.” Zechariah 2:8-13

“According to the promise that I covenanted with you when you came out of Egypt, so My Spirit stands and abides in the midst of you; fear not. (6) For thus says the Lord of hosts: Yet once more, in a little while, I will shake and make tremble the [starry] heavens, the earth, the sea, and the dry land; (7) And I will shake all nations and the desire and the precious things of all nations shall come in, and I will fill this house with splendor, says the Lord of hosts (Is. 60:5; Matt. 2:1-11). (8) The silver is Mine and the gold is Mine, says the Lord of hosts. (9) The latter glory of this house [with its successor, to which Jesus came] shall be greater than the former, says the Lord of hosts; and in this place in time and history will I give peace and prosperity, says the Lord of hosts.” Haggai 2:5-9

### **The wealth and riches and glory of the world has always belonged to God's people**

“When the Lord reversed the prosperity back to Zion, we were like those who dream, we wondered could this be real? (2) At the suddenly, our mouths will be filled with laughter, and our tongues with singing. Everyone will declare among the nations, The Lord has done great things for them. (3) We ourselves will echo, ‘The Lord has done great things for us! We are glad!’ (4) Jehovah, you have promised to turn to freedom our captivity and restore our fortunes, O Lord, as the streams in the South, the Negab, find their replenishment from the torrents of a flood. (5) Surely we will see those who have sown in tears harvesting with rejoicing! (6) Yea, the people who go forth bearing seed of a precious harvest, weeping with compassion, being refreshed and nourished by His precious supply for sowing, undoubtedly, will return again with rejoicing, bringing reports of the great harvest with them.” Psalms 126

“Oh, that the salvation and deliverance of God's people would come! When God restores the fortunes of His people, then will they be glad. Psalms 53:6

“Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favour my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the Lord be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant.” Psalms 35:27

“Wealth and riches are in my house and my righteousness endures forever.” Psalms 112:3

### **From the book of Isaiah (the Messianic Book).**

[From the Thompson Chain Reference Study Bible heading of Isaiah 60, “the glory of the church in the abundance access of the Gentiles; her (the church) great blessing after a short affliction.]

“Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee. (2) For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the Lord shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee. (3) And the Gentiles shall come to thy light, and kings to the brightness of thy rising. Isaiah 60:1-3

V5 “Then you shall see and be radiant, and your heart shall thrill and tremble with joy [at the glorious deliverance] and be enlarged; because the abundant wealth of the Sea [the rich sea trade and the wealth of nations] shall be turned to you, unto you shall the nations come with their treasures.”

V6 “The multitude of camels [Heb. For any burden bearing labor to bring goods] shall cover [Heb. for overwhelm] thee... they shall bring gold and incense; and they shall shew forth the praises of the Lord.”

V11 “And your gates shall be open continually, they shall not be shut day or night, that men may bring to you the wealth [Heb. forces, riches, wealth, goods, means, men and other resources] of the nations; their kings shall come bring their honor to you.”

V15 “You were despised refuse-- out-of-the-way, unvisited, ignored. But now I've put you on your feet, towering and grand forever, a joy of many past generations to look at!

V16 “ When you suck the milk of nations and the breasts of royalty, You'll know that I, God, am your Savior, your Redeemer.” [From the notes of Preacher John Wesley, “shall suck” refers to that the church shall draw, or receive the wealth of nations, and the riches, and power of kings, and whatever is most excellent, and that it shall come freely, and affectionately, as milk flows from the breast of the mother.]

V17 “ I'll give you only the best--no more hand-me-downs! Gold instead of bronze, silver instead of iron, bronze instead of wood, iron instead of stones. I'll install Peace as your business, make Righteousness your boss.”

“To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn; (3) To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness... that he might be glorified.” Isaiah 61:2-3

V6 “But ye shall be named the Priests of the Lord: men shall call you the Ministers of our God: ye shall eat [Heb. consume] the riches of the Gentiles, and in their glory shall ye boast [Heb. exchange; change places with and boast] yourselves.”

V9 “And their seed shall be known among the Gentiles, and their offspring among the people: all that see them shall acknowledge them, that they are the seed which the Lord hath blessed.”

“But everything she gets, all the money she takes in, will be turned over to God. It will not be put in banks. Her profits will be put to the use of God-Aware, God-Serving-People, providing plenty of food and the best of clothing.” Isaiah 23:18

### **What is our response?**

“But to you, brethren, I say, ‘Be patient, be expectant, waiting for God’s appearance on the scene to do what He has promised. Does not the farmer wait expectantly for the precious harvest? He tirelessly guards over his hope, waiting for both the early and later rains. (8) Well dear ones, settle it your heart to also be patient. Know without a doubt, God’s arrival on the scene is very near.” (9) Whatever you do, don’t join the complaining crowd, rather congregate with those rejoicing. Keep your eye open for the great reconciliation promised. The Judge’s arrival is just around the corner. (10) Mimic the ancient prophets of old. They endured death defying odds while showing their trust and confidence in God. (11) Their legacy is a gift of life to those of us who pay attention! The ancient man, Job, stand out as the prime example of this heritage. Remember what God proved to Job; that those who finish the course find it very, very good!” James 5:7-11

### **Summary.**

God looks out at this world of darkness and wickedness and sin and people doing their own selfish thing and says, “I want my bumper crop (James 5) of souls and I am going to get my harvest.” The Body of Christ will allow God to enlarge their hearts, as Solomon did. Through the transfer of wealth and riches from the Gentiles (Isaiah 60 and 61), we will I go to the hungry and thirsty, but not leave them hungry and thirsty. Their lives will be totally changed as the body of Christ brings them God’s goods and the Gospel. They will accept Jesus Christ and the glory of the world in goods and substances will come to them as well.
