of the “Day of the Lord of Hosts” (Is. 2:12)**

For “*doctrine, reproof, correction, and instruction in righteousness*” (2 Timothy 3:16)

Genesis 2:12	“ <i>Gold is good,</i> ” or beautiful, wonderful, precious
Genesis 8:21-9:2	God’s people had their blessings restored
Genesis 15:13-14	A great substance is the created glory of God! It is a reflection of how great our God is. The Apostle Paul talked about different kinds of glory in 1 Corinthians 15. God’s people will go out with wealth because it is the prosperity covenant wherein the anointing is rooted. The order states that Abraham was first blessed, then a blessing.
Exodus 14	The story of the first event of a prosperity plundering.
Numbers 18:20-32	The law and order of tithing, being a most holy thing.
Deuteronomy 4:32	God tells us what He says is the greatest event from the creation of the world.
Deuteronomy 9:1-4	The <i>Day of the Lord of Hosts--Jehovah Tsaba</i> is happening not because we can say, “I’ve passed all of the financial tests.” However, our hearts must be enlarged to receive it, and the “rules” are different than they are with the law of sowing and reaping.
Deuteronomy 28:47	Being joyful and grateful brings in blessings from God.
Joshua 1:3	It will be necessary to possess both the land and the enemies over our lands.
Joshua 5:7	The reproach [shame, disgrace, scorn from the enemy] has been rolled away.
1 Samuel 17:45	David fought Goliath in the name of the Lord of Hosts, the lord of battles and angelic armies.
2 Kings 3:16	We dig ditches for a deluge of wealth to flow towards us.
Job 27:13-17	The wicked man heaps up silver for the righteous.
Ecclesiastes 2:24-26	It is very godly to enjoy our labor.
Ecclesiastes 5:18-19	We all have our allotted portions, which is good.
Psalms 1:3	Whatever a believer touches in faith prospers.
Psalms 34:1-3	To boast is to brag loudly, to make larger, to proudly speak of or to magnify.
Psalms 35:27	The Lord takes pleasure in our prosperity. We magnify Him (make a loud noise).
Psalms 37:1-9	We have not made this connection of inheritance correctly, but it is a key to The <i>Day of the Lord of Hosts--Jehovah Tsaba</i> . Wealth is not ours inherently, but is given as a gift by inheritance. An inheritance comes at an appointed time, which is now.
Psalms 66:12	God will bring us out into a wealthy place.
Psalms 103:20	Shouting is the signal to the angels to go out and get the intangible into existence. We shout for joy! God’s pleasure is for us to be prosperous.
Proverbs 13:22	Wealth will be acquired supernaturally (Psalms 37:27).
Isaiah 26:13	“ <i>Other lords have rules over us.</i> ” Only God can deliver His people from the poverty slavery of “bills to bills and paychecks to paychecks” mentality, like He did with the Israelite slaves in Egypt.
Isaiah 47:4	Jesus is our Redeemer, and Jehovah Tsaba.
Jeremiah 29:11	Our expected end, the <i>Day of the Lord of Hosts--Jehovah Tsaba</i> , is a place to prosper. Peace includes prosperity.
Mark 10:29-30	Jesus will fulfill this promise in this age.
Luke 4:6	This glory is the created splendid precious things God made for us to enjoy and receive.
Romans 1:18-25	God put himself in the things that He made. God’s created glory is also a part of worshiped, but just not before He is worshipped.
Romans 10:14	God rules over all.
1 Corinthians 10:32	The Church is not called Gentiles, but is one of 3 groups in the earth today.
2 Corinthians 4:4	God has never called Satan a god.
2 Corinthians 9:8	God is able to make all this prosperity come to us to be self sufficient.
1 Peter 2:9	The Body of Christ is a nation, the nation God has His eye on now.
Hebrews 12:26	This is the report of a one more time event, which will be in a little while.
